Both owners were granted special ex-ception use permits by the Farming-ton Flansing Commission Monday.

Another Farmington day-care cen-ter, Country Hills Montessori Center for Children, received site plen ap-proval for an outside recreation area at its Orchard Lake Road site. With two new centers, Farmington will have four licensed day-care facili-ties.

The flurry of activity involving day

care is unusual, but may signal a larger trude. Parmington, known for its senior population, is getting a younger face as couples with preschool children are moving in.


While Rhymes and Reasons is already in husiness, Hills resident.
