Animal Care Fair to benefit humane society

A select group of metro-area dogs and cats will be dressing for success — or at least a chance to win a \$500 gift certificate from Pet Supplies Plus — on Saturday, Aug. 26.

It's all part of Animal Care Fair '95, an animal adoption and fund-raising event sponsored by the Michigan Humane Society and the Livonia-based Pet Supplies Plus chain.

Held on the Southfield Civic Center front lawn, the Care Fair will feature a variety of entertaining animal-oriented events, including the finals of the "Best Dressed Pet In Detroit" contest.

The Care Fair's panel of judges has received thousands of photos of dogs and cats attired in various outfits, from Dalmatians in dresses and Boxers in briefs, to cats in bonnets and Pomeranians in motorcycle jackets.

The best dressed pet finalists will be competing for the \$500 gift certificate and other prizes on Saturday at Animal Care Fair '95.

In addition to the Best Dressed Pet Finals, the Care Fair will feature acrobatic exhibitions by the Pet Supplies Plus Classic K-9 Team. A nationally famous dog training and racing team, the Classic K-9s have appeared on Good Morning America and other network TV programs.

Fair-goers will also marvel at the feats performed by the Maximum Overdrive Dog Training Team, Bryan Lemky and his Frisbee dogs "Tat" and "Axi," the Oakland County Sheriff's Department Mounted Unit, and the Michigan State Police K-9 Unit.

Aside from these events, the Care Fair will include educational sessions on pet health, grooming and training. "Anything you want to know about caring for your pet, you'll be able to find out at the fair," said Michele Mitchell, a spokeswoman for The Michigan Humane Society.

The Michigan Humane Society will also be selling pet food and supplies (donated by Pet Supplies Plus and its suppliers) at deep discounts. All proceeds raised from the sale of this merchandise, as well as from the sale of refreshments, goes to help the Michigan Humane Society operate its three animal shelters in Wayne and Oakland Counties.

For many people, the highlight of Animal Care Fair '95 will be seeing the adoptable dogs and cats on hand from the Michigan Humane Society. All of the animals brought to the fair by the Humane Society will be available for adoption to good homes.

At last year's Animal Care Fair, the society placed 129 dogs and cats with new families.

"The Animal Care Fair is one of the most important adoption and fund-raising events of the year for the Michigan Humane Society, and our company is proud to be a part of it," said Jack Berry, the president and founder of Pet Supplies Plus.

"Our company has grown from a single pet store in Redford to a national chain with over 100 locations, and we owe our success to dogs and cats. So we're happy to

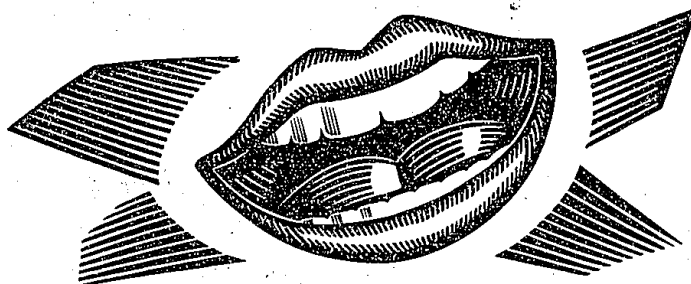
do anything we can to help animals find new homes."
