Boy, 2, hurt in fall from church balcony

A Farmington Hills boy, 2, was discharged from the hospital Tuesday after falling from a balcony at Our Lady of Sorrows Church during a Mass last Sunday.
The boy suffered a fractured skull after he slipped through a railing and fell 10 feet, striking

his head on a stairwell, according to Farmington police reports. He is expected to recover fully.
The boy was attending Mass with his parents, Robert and Beverly Haynor of Farmington Hills.
He was conscious when medical emergency crews arrived but had notable swelling on the side of his head. He was taken to Botsford Hospital and was later trans-

ferred to Henry Ford Hospital's Intensive Care Unit.
He came home Tuesday afternoon, said his father.
"He's doing good," Bob Haynor said. "He just walked in the door. We're grateful for all the support we received from friends and the church community."
Our Lady of Sorrows officials immediately covered openings in

the balcony with plastic, said Monsignor Walter Hurley. The situation has existed for years, but church officials weren't aware of the potential danger until the accident.
"I felt so badly about it," Hurley said. "I visited him and his family a couple of times in the hospital. We are so grateful he's doing well."
