

POLICE/FIRE CALLS

Listed below are some of the Farmington-area police incidents, fire calls and court cases reported during the past week.

**ASSAULT**  
A developmentally disabled West Bloomfield man, 54, said he had been locked in a closet, sprayed with a hose and beaten with a board while working at the Detroit Baptist Manor on 13 Mile in Farmington Hills Aug. 10. But a woman who worked there had said the man beat himself. The man had injuries to his face and leg. Farmington Hills police are investigating.

**DRUNKEN DRIVING**  
Farmington Hills police arrested a Walled Lake woman, 19, for drunken driving at 4 a.m. Aug. 25. Officers pulled over a 1995 Ford after it swerved onto the shoulder and hit a guardrail at Drake while traveling west on M-5. The woman had a blood alcohol level of .18 percent. A level of .1 percent is considered too drunk to drive in Michigan.
