While there are many roof ven-tilation systems on the markot, a balanced system of soffit and con-tinuous ridge vents provides the most efficient ventilation method, according to Horvat.

Soffit vents, installed under the caves of a home, provide an inlet of air flow. Ridge vents, installed across the entire roofs peak, or ridge, supply an outlet for air

flow. According to Horvat, this system alds in reducing heat build-up and ezcess moleture, and heips to keep the roof dock temperature uniform. Because ridge vents help keep roof docks cool in winter, they also help pre-vent ice dama, which leads to a longer-lasting roof.
