"Paganini was the victim of a
rare jawhone disease, and after
several operations, had to have all
of his teeth pulled out," explained
Lane. "This left his face sunken
and skeleton-like, and gave him
ancabre appearance. It was a
common belief that Paganii,
whose name means 'little pegan'
was able to execute super human
technical feats on the violin, because he had sold his soul to the
devil. In reality, his awesome
technique was the result of persevering parents who simply
made him practice the violin all
