Jerry McKenzie will be drumming up some familiar tunes to Stan Kenton fans when he joins the Johnny Trudell orchestra in a tribute to the late band leader at the Arriva restaurant on 12 Mile Road between Mound and Van Dyke in Warren Oct. 2-7.

McKenzie, a veteran Farmington Hills police officer, played with the Stan Kenton band for stints with the Glenn Miller Orchestra, under the direction of Ray McKinley, and the Jimmy Dorsey Band, under the direction of Jimmy Castle.

The band will be joined by the Four Freshmen and vocalist Sandra Mandela. Matt Michaels, a professor of jazz studies at Wayne State University, will play piano in the Kenton style during the shows.

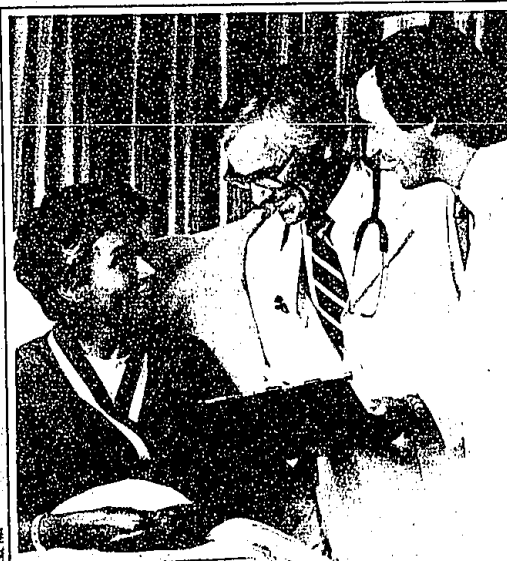
