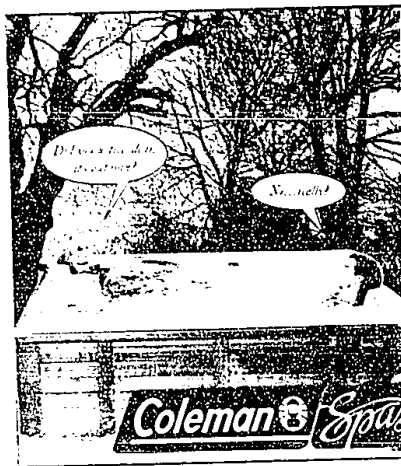




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Haunted Winery to give kids a Halloween scare

The Haunted Winery usually is a scary place for kids to be in the days before Halloween, and this October is no exception.

Associated with the Farmington Historical Commission, the Haunted Winery offers Halloween-type haunted house activities for youngsters. It is in the 115-year-old building with the tall smokestack at 3163 Grand River near Orchard Lake Road, Farmington.

The building, previously a powerhouse for an electric rail-

road and then a winery, now houses small shops.

Sneak preview weekends will be Oct. 6-8 and 13-15, and nightly scares will be held Oct. 19-30. Hours: 7-10 p.m. Sunday, Tuesday, Wednesday and Thursday; 7-11 p.m. Friday and Saturday. The facility will be closed Monday, Oct. 23.

Admission is \$6 for adults 13 and over and \$3 for youngsters 12 and under. Proceeds will benefit the Farmington Historical Museum and The Winery. For more information, call 477-8833.

Classes, workshop offered at Farmington Community School
