"Caryn was a couple years younger than my daughter, yet I could relate to her real well. There wasn't that generation gap, if you will," said Nyquist. "She was a bubbly, very outgoing "Avyear-old." Nyquist recalled that Casa-helped Ford techieve its first Corporate Cup championship last June when she ran an impressive 39:35 on a 10-kilometer cross country course at Casa Benton. She finished first among the Ford

women, and second overall.

Ford had plans for Casaz. The company recruited her out of the University of Illinois for its college graduate program, which grooms candidates for management.

Casaz graduated in December of 1933 and moved to Farmington Hills before starting with Ford in February 1934. She spent a year working in Dearborn before being assigned to Atlanta for six

munths to help isunch the Taurus. She'd just returned to Michigan Sept. 10. "She moved in with me and my husband and had saved a lot of money. She was going to buy a house in Ann Arboo," said Byndas.

When at 8 p.m. there still was no sign of Casaz, Byndas' hus-

band, Brian, went looking for Casaz. The Byndases learned from the police that something had happened to Casaz, and drove to the hospital.

"A doctor told me to ait down, and I knew something was terribly wrong," said Byndas. Byndas was told it wann't known whether "the woman in the next room was my sister, because she had no identification, but if it was, she was dead. It was the worst feeling
