Two clematis vines, which have white blooms, grow on the fence that backs this garden. A very elegant hibiscus was full of large saucer-like pink blossoms, which Carter said had been blooming well since it began and each bloom lasts only one day.

Another area of the property has been devoted to vegetables. Here we found tumips, collard greens ("which can take hard freeze"), melons, tomatoes,

squash, lettuces, carrots, hot chili aquain, retuces, carrots, not chippepers, verrbearing red raspberries, okra, large aweet Belgian peppers (the seeds came from a friend) and cucumbers. Every fall the vegetable gardens are
