Harry and Helen Greenlee, both 93, will celebrate their 71st wedding anniversary today, which is also Helen's 93 birthday. The Greenlees, Farmington residents, came from central Indiana in 1933 and have lived in Michigan ever since. Harry was taken from an Indiana orphanage at 11 and given to an elderly farm couple in 1913. He stayed with them only a few months, then drifted in and out of odd jobs with friendly people in the area sustaining him. Harry attended a small, one-room, brick school house, where he met Helen. They dated eight years and got married when they

were 22 in 1924. Harry, with only a high school diploma, found jobs with several automotive companies. He worked as a staff engineer for 15 years at Chrysler. He has been retired for 32 years.

Until recently, Helen made robes and afghans; mostly for patients at the Arnold Home, while Harry wrote many letters to their church's Ill-and-Homebough. Harry also bowls twice a week. They spend their summers at their cabin on the Big Muskegon River near Hardy Dam and their winters in Farmington Kensington Manor.

They have two children, five grandchildren, five great-grandchildren and three great-great-grandchildren.
