VIKINGS FOOTBALL

Danny Mikhail scored three touchdowns Sunday to lead the NFWB Vikings varsity football team in its 21-12 victory over the Ann Arbor Wildcats.

Mikhail caught a touchdown pass from Mitch Maier, returned a kickoff 65 yards for a score and ran 33 yards for a fourth-quarter touchdown.

The Vikings (5-2-1) play the Ypsilanti Braves (6-1-1) in the playoffs Sunday at Wayne Memorial High School.

The NFWB junior varsity defeated the Wildcats 25-6 to finish with a first-place record of 7-0-1 in the division.

NO THREE WRESTLING




