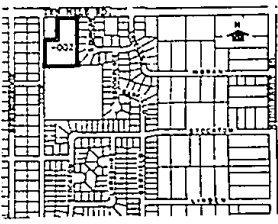

A regular meeting of the Farmington City Council was called to order by Mayor Campbell at 8:00 p.m. on Monday, November 6, 1995 in Council Chambers, 21600 Liberty Street, Farmington, Michigan. Notice of the meeting was posted in compliance with Public Act 267-1976.
PRESENT: Bush, Campbell, Hartsock, McShane, Tupper.
ABSENT: None.
OTHERS PRESENT: City Clerk Cantrell, City Attorney Donohue, Director Goss, Director Gushman, City Manager Lauboff, Assistant to City Manager Richards.
Minutes of Special and Regular Meetings of October 16, 1995 were approved as submitted.
Minutes of other boards were received and filed.
Council directed Administration to contact Maggie Loras to discuss her offer to volunteer to assist senior citizens with special needs.
Council authorized participation in the 1996 Girls State Program and appointed Councilperson Bush as a contact person.
Council established a Public Hearing for the 1996-97 Community Development Block Grant Program to be held November 20, 1995 at 8:00 p.m.
Council introduced Ordinance No. C-625-95 amending Traffic Control Orders, Chapter 6, by adding Section 6.11 regarding "no turn on red" for eastbound Shawwassee at Farmington Road.
Council approved amendments to the Cemetery Rules and Regulations, Section 1.111 prohibiting dogs from all cemeteries.
Council approved a contract between the Michigan State Transportation Commission and the City for maintenance of Grand River.
Council authorized an emergency purchase of one 1996 Ford Crown Victoria police package patrol vehicle at a cost of \$19,160.00 and authorized amendment of the FY 1995-96 budget.
City Attorney Donohue reported to Council on Decriminalization of Select Misdemeanor Offenses.
There were no public comments.
Council comments and announcements were heard.
Council authorized donation of two used computers to the Senior Program.
Council received and filed the Building Department Quarterly Report, July through September, 1995.
