conference at Fairlene Town Cen-ter in Dearborn Nov. 15 to focus media attention on the busiest re-tail time of the year, the months of November and December, when according to Robert Taubman, president of Taubman Centers, retailers do one third of their an-restallers do one third of their annual business.

nual business.

Taubman reported that nation-all retailers predict sales of 3-5 percent over 1994, with Michigan consumers planning to spend an average of \$77 for each person on

their list compared to \$58 last year. Those surveyed expect to buy gifts for 17 people, compared to 15 people in 1994.

Both surveys found underlying confidence in the economy, tempered by continuing concerns about the future. Sixty-percent of consumers said they will shop at department atores and specialty shops (retail outlets generally found in malls) compared to 66-percent from last year.

"She stopped in one night, saw our great selection of wines and


