"Anatomy of a Murder" (USA - 1959): 7:30 p.m. Nov. 28. Jimmy Stewart plays a small-town lawyer who defends a man whose guilt on a murder charge remains ambiguous at best. Striving for authenticity, director Otto Preminger brought cast and crew to the tiny Upper Peninsula town of Big Bay, Michigan, where the murder actually occurred. Duke Ellington provides the jazzy soundtrack.
