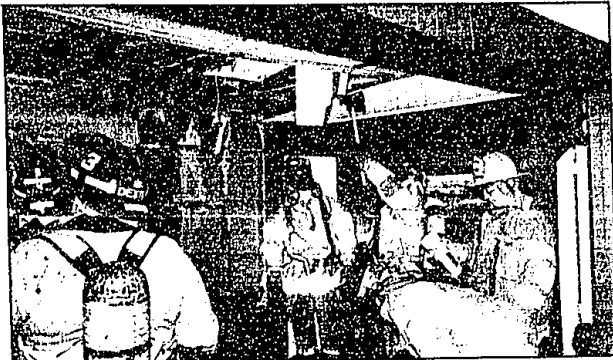


**Fire place problem**
