

Qualifiers add up on math test

Thirty-two Farmington-area students have qualified for the second part of the 89th-annual Michigan Mathematics Prize Competition.

Students made the grade by finishing in the top 6 percent out of nearly 16,000 test-takers in 360 schools across the state that took Part I of the exam Oct. 11. Those who qualified take the Part II math test Wednesday, Dec. 6.

The 100 students with the highest combined scores in the Part II test will be invited to a banquet at Grand Valley State University March 2. Of those, the top-50 will receive scholarships ranging from \$400 to \$2,400.

In last year's competition, North Farmington junior Andy Stein placed in the top-100 in the state. The competition is sponsored by the Michigan Section of the Mathematical Association.

Lamontaine said the fire started about 2:30 or 2:45 p.m. and the flames were put out within 10 minutes, although it may have been an hour before the smoke was under control. He said there were between 15 and 20 firefighters at the scene.
