FOOTBALL AWARDS

Senior Jason Granger was named the most valuable player on the 1995 Farmington Hills Harrison football team Sunday. The announcement, along with that of other award winners, was made at the team's post-season banquet at Vladimir's in Farmington Hills.

Granger, a three-year starter at tailback, rushed for more than 1,500 yards this year and is second only to John Miller in career rushing with over 4,000 yards.

Senior and Alex Stolinicki was named the most improved player, and senior back Steve Catherman was honored as the scholar-athlete with a 3.7 grade-point average.

Junior linebacker/fullback Nick Shaleb won the Stuck Award as well as the outstanding back honor.

Other award winners included senior center Brad Donahue, Rock of Granite; junior tackle

Francis Gojcek, outstanding lineman; sophomore back Chris Ghanman, BQTR (best of the rest) as the top scout team player; and senior noseguard Ian Sweet, Spirit Award.

Longtime Harrison assistant coach and special teams coordinator John Witkowski will be inducted into the Michigan High School Coaches Hall of Fame in March. Witkowski has coached at Harrison for the last 18 years.
