

POLICE/FIRE CALLS

Listed below are some of the Farmington-area police incidents, fire calls and court cases reported during the past week.

FIRE DEPARTMENT RUNS

Farmington Hills firefighters made 428 runs for the month of November including 248 medical emergencies (58 percent), 43 rescues (10 percent), 30 services calls (7 percent) and 12 fires (3 percent). As of Nov. 27, the Hills fire department had gone on 4,641 runs, equal to the number of runs for all of 1994.

FIRES

Farmington Hills firefighters from Station 2 put out a fire in a 1986 Chevy van engine while it was on the shoulder of westbound I-696 west of Drake in Farmington Hills at 11:37 a.m. Dec. 3. The owner said he had recent transmission work done. He noticed smoke in his rear view mirror and pulled over. Damage to the van was \$3,000 and damage to contents was \$100.

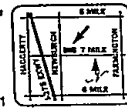
