trom the council and addrence to the candidates. Kurzeja and candidates Barry Brickner, Richard Corey, Dennis Fitzgerald and Soronen fielded the questions confidently. Former Mayor Ben Marks could not attend due to the flu.

Brickner, an attorney who has been active in local politics and subdivision association business, cited his ability as a businessman, expertise in computer technology and ability to work with

people to resolve disputes as

strong points.
"I have expertise in computer technology," he said. "I'm an author on the subject. I'm the attorney computer nerd of Oakland County."

Corey, who has served on the zoning board of appeals, economic development commission, Year 2000 Committee and others, said he would keep an open mind, but now traffic is the top issue the city faces.

"I think being able to listen to people is half of the battle in business," said the business con-sultant.

Fitzgerald, who emphasized looking at increasing revenues rather than just cutting spending to contain the budget, said business expertise is not essential for a council member, but is an ad-

wantage.


