as a human being. They don't want us to be afraid of them."

Angels are not an endangered species.

"They're not cupids flying with bows and arrows. Angels are kick ass creatures," says Bruno. He recalls the Biblical story of one angel that slew 180,000 people.

In another testimonial Bruno recounted, a woman was followed out of a shopping mall by two suspicious characters who chased her to her car and pounded on the window as she tried to pull away. When the car wouldn't start, she asked for God's help. She sped away leaving tire tracks on the pavement. After telling the story to her husband at home, he went outside to check under the hood of their car and discovered the battery was gone — which should have prevented her from driving.

A man in northern Michigan told Bruno of the time he fell off his tractor and watched as the blade came perilously close to severing his leg. He asked for God's help and the tractor

stalled. When he climbed back on the machine, he saw the key was in the turned off position.

"Angels have an agreement with God to be with us. Every one may have more than one (guardian) angel," Bruno said. "Some people need to be more in tune to feeling their presence."

Bruno believes angels are here "to let us know that God loves us and also to help us with the mess we've created (on earth). Angels are doing more and saying less than ever before. They appear and disappear. They don't want to be worshipped."

"Angels are time travelers across the universe. God works through angels."

"I'm not a Bible stumping fanatic," he insisted. "But the evidence gets overwhelming. There must be something going on here."

Bruno left his rapt audience with three principles.

"You are not alone. You have never been alone. And you will never be alone," he said. "Believe this in your heart."
