**Listed below are some of the Farmington-area police incidents, fire calls and court cases reported during the past week.**

**■ FIRES**  
A Farmington Hills police officer called Hills firefighters about smoke coming from the roof of the Topps Motel on Grand River in Farmington Hills at 11:15 a.m. Jan. 31. The officer found an ignited bird's nest behind some aluminum siding near the gas furnace exhaust. Firefighters shut off the gas supply to the furnace and hot water heater. Damage was estimated at \$2,000 to the property.

**■ ASSAULT**  
Three Farmington Hills teens, 17, 16 and 15, told Hills police that they were assaulted by five teens. The suspects, from Southfield, Farmington, Walled Lake and Livonia, came through the rear door of a residence on Jefferson in Farmington Hills at 7:30 p.m. Jan. 30. One of the victims was kicked in the head and needed stitches, and a pregnant 15-year-old was stepped on.  
A Troy woman, 44, told Farmington Hills police that a man, 20,

whom she was evicting from her rental property on Greening, pushed her and pinned her to a van using his forearm against her neck at 3:19 p.m. Feb. 1. Another man, 17, threatened two other men with a mop handle. The angry tenant also hit the men, 31 of Redford and 38 of Waterford, during the incident.

**■ THEFT**  
A \$200 cellular phone was stolen from a maroon 1993 VW Eurovan parked on Raphael in Farmington Hills Jan. 26.

**■ BREAK-INS**  
The driver's window was broken causing \$250 in damage to a 1996 Nissan Maxima parked at Complete Business Solutions on 12 Mile and a \$100 radar detector was stolen Jan. 24.

Police found an eight-pound rock and a shopping cart, which was used to break the door. Around 1 a.m. Feb. 2, police spotted two juveniles near the east side of the building who fled. The glass door was cracked at the cleaners, causing \$400 in damage.


**■ AUTO THEFTS**

She was taken to Hutford Hospital. "Doctors say she is doing fairly well," a hospital spokeswoman said.
