Hills Mayor Aldo Vagnozzi sald the issue was one of home rule.

"We are slways hearing how the state doesn't want the folderal government tolling it what to do and how to run things." he said. "Now they (state) want to tell us how to run things."

Honigman said the bill not only makes exceptions for paid-on-call firefighters as a practical matter, but may in its final form exclude some elected officials, city managers and others. And the agreement would not affect contracts already negotiated.

negotiated.
"It would take effect in those cases after the

contract had run out," he said.
State Rep. Jan Dolan, R-Farmington Hills, was unequivocal in her opposition to the bill.

"I don't think it's the state's business," she said. "The cratishly going to work against it. Maybe that's because I've worked in local government. I think it's hypocritical for the state to complain about the federal government telling them how to run the state and then turning around and doing the same to us."

The bill would likely not take effect until at least April 1, 1997, if it does pass.
