

## POLICE/FIRE CALLS

Listed below are some of the Farmington-area police incidents, fire calls and court cases reported during the past week.

■ **FIRES**

Farmington Hills firefighters extinguished a vehicle fire on Northwestern Highway at 5:27 p.m. Feb. 26. Electrical wiring ignited in the engine compartment of the 1990 Ford F150 Transap Vehicle, causing \$700 damage.

■ **ATTEMPTED BURGLARY**

An alert motorist on M-5 called Farmington police after seeing two subjects tamper with the rear door of Colonial Car Wash on Nine Mile Road around 10 p.m.

Feb. 24. Officers found one of the windows broken, but nothing appeared to have been stolen.

■ **AUTO THEFT**

The burned out vehicle was found by Detroit police on Harding Street with keys in the ignition. Police suspect arson. 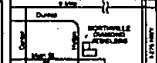

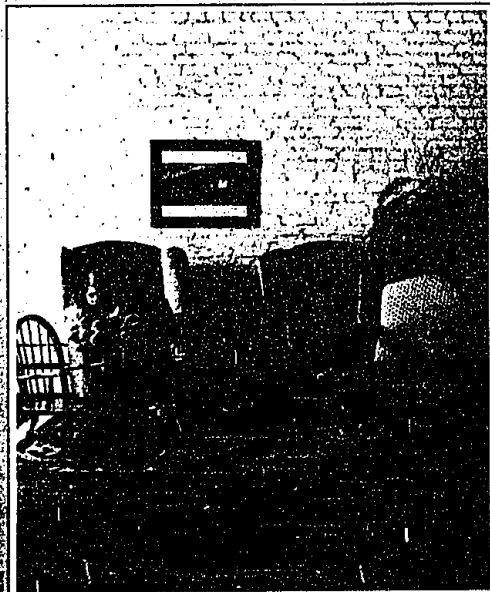
