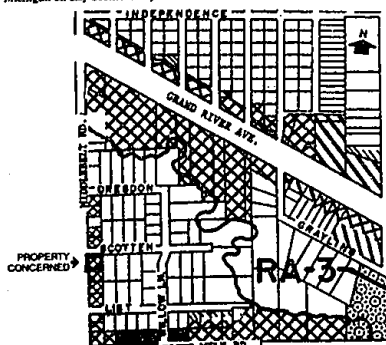

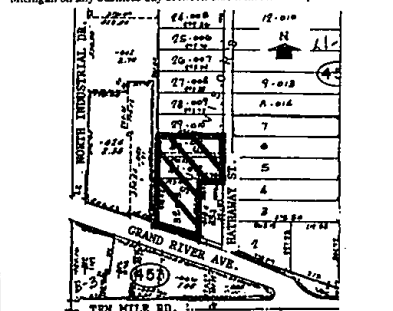

### Community Development Block Grant Program Program Year 1996/97

The U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development has advised the City of Farmington Hills that it is entitled to receive \$451,000 for the 1996/97 Community Development Block Grant Program year plus an additional \$12,124.00 in reallocated funds. These funds have been authorized by the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development under Title 1 of the Housing and Community Development Act of 1974 and 1977, as amended. In addition, the Housing Rehabilitation Program will have a fund balance of \$40,000 and an estimated \$60,000 will be received in program income from the Housing Rehabilitation activities. Notice is hereby given that on Monday, March 18, 1996, at 7:30 p.m., Eastern Standard Time, in the Council Chambers of the City Hall, 31555 Eleven Mile Road, City of Farmington Hills, Oakland County, Michigan, at which time and place the Farmington Hills City Council will conduct a Public Hearing to discuss the proposed use of Community Development Block Grant funds (Action Plan: One Year Use of Funds).

The proposed statement of Community Development Objectives and Projected Use of Funds for the 1996/97 CDBG Program Year is as follows:

### PROPOSED STATEMENT OF COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT BLOCK GRANT PROGRAM 1996/96 City of Farmington Hills

The City of Farmington Hills has considered the various eligible projects which may be undertaken with Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) funds. These activities range from construction of sidewalks, storm/sewerage systems, water lines, and street paving to public services, code enforcement, historic preservation, etc. After careful evaluation of these projects, it has been determined that the highest priority of needs for low and moderate income areas in the community would be achieved through the following expenditure of CDBG funds:

Activity	1995/96 Budget	Proposed 1996/97
Housing Rehabilitation	\$234,000.00	\$170,124.00*
Capital Improvements	\$22,000.00	\$03,000.00
Administration	\$8,000.00	\$0,000.00
Total:	\$636,000.00	\$553,124.00*

\*Includes program income (\$60,000) and fund balance (\$40,000)

Capital improvement projects for possible consideration include:

Grand River Improvements (Section 35 and 36) - right-of-way safety improvements - street and pedestrian lighting	\$150,000.00
Tuck Road Reconstruction (Section 26)	123,000.00
Rhoadwood Drain Improvements (Section 36)	30,000.00
Total:	\$303,000.00

Please note that only a portion of these projects could be completed due to the funding levels. It is felt, however, that an opportunity for public discussion should be given on these projects, and other possible projects.

All projects proposed with the use of the 1996/97 CDBG funds, as noted above, will benefit low and moderate income areas or persons defined in the 1990 U.S. Census.

All CDBG activities have been designed to avoid the displacement of persons. In the event displacement becomes necessary the City will assist displaced persons in accordance with the Federal Uniform Relocation Act.

The 1996/96 CDBG Program - the Final Statement of Community Development Objectives and Projected Use of Funds for 1996/96 Program Year included the above distribution of funds. It is anticipated that on June 30, 1996 the end of the Program Year, the status of the expenditures will be as follows:

### HOUSING REHABILITATION: 61% EXPENDED

(Approximately \$40,000 will be carried over for future rehabilitation activities.)

### CAPITAL IMPROVEMENTS: Middlebelt/Eldon Storm Drain under construction

(Estimated cost \$100,000)  
Grand River R.O.W. Improvements (Phase I) completed  
(Estimated Cost: \$327,000)

Gill Road sidewalk - project cancelled with funds used for Middlebelt/Eldon Storm Drain (\$0)

Independence intersection improvements completed  
(Estimated cost: \$55,000)

Shiawassee intersection improvements in design  
(Estimated cost: \$25,000)

ADMINISTRATION: 100% EXPENDED (\$80,000.00)

Also, no persons will be displaced by the above activities.
