

Moped driver tries to scoot away from Hills police chase

A flea of a motorized vehicle was involved in a fleeing and eluding police chase. The driver, a Farmington Hills man, 21, has been charged in the case involving a stolen 1988 Honda Elite moped March 1. The driver was arrested after crashing the moped while trying to jump a berm onto Freedom Road, police said. The moped was reported stolen from Farmington High on Nov. 14. At 1:56 p.m., a Farmington police officer saw the moped traveling on the south sidewalk along eastbound Grand River. The moped driver refused to stop when the officer put on his emergency lights. Instead, the moped entered the

Dolphin Center parking lot, crossed Sherwood Street and went through Dusseau Lincoln Mercury before appearing again on the sidewalk along Grand River. The moped veered inside the Winery parking lot and between D/W Oil and a Cligo station towards Nine Mile Road. The driver entered a field off Ruth Street when he failed to get over the berm that led to Freedom Road. In a written statement to police, the driver admitted wrongdoing. "I got scared and ran today from police," he said in the statement. "I should've stopped." The driver was charged with fleeing and eluding, possession of stolen property and driving with a suspended license.
