

POLICE/FIRE CALLS

Listed below are some of the Farmington-area police incidents, fire calls and court cases reported during the past week.

■ FIRE DEPARTMENT RUNS

Farmington Hills firefighters made 95 runs for the week of March 25-31 including 55 (58 percent) medical emergencies, seven rescues and 11 service calls. That brought the monthly total to 451 runs with 52 percent being medical emergencies, 28 fires (6 percent) and 40 rescues (9 percent).

■ FIRES

Farmington Hills firefighters from Station 4 put out a fire in a 1993 Ford Aerostar van parked in northeast Farmington Hills at 7:46 a.m. March 29. The fire had started in the load carrying area among scrap newspapers. The driver delivers newspapers. The driver had been walking the dog when the van caught fire. There was \$8,000 in damage to the van and \$500 in damage to contents. Station 2 firefighters are investigating a fire that caused \$100 in

damage to a house site under construction at Hollyhill in Farmington Hills at 9:20 a.m. March 31. A full case of beer and empty beer cans were also found at the site. Farmington firefighters responded to a kitchen fire at a Mayfield Street residence at 5:21 p.m. March 29. The fire, which started when grease in a frying pan ignited, was put out prior to their arrival.

■ BREAK-INS

More than \$3,700 worth of

items were stolen during a break-in at the Nine/Grand Party Store on Grand River in Farmington between 10 p.m. and 6 a.m. May 27. The front window of the business was smashed and a pry bar was found inside. Phone lines were also cut. Items stolen include: several cartons of cigarettes (\$1,800), 15 Motorola pagers (\$900), Michigan Instant Lottery tickets (\$400) and \$200 cash. A .38 caliber pistol was also stolen. The car door locks of a green

1985 Ford Thunderbird were pried open (\$300) and a \$250 AM/FM stereo was stolen March 30-31. A \$500 air conditioning unit was stolen from the window of a residence on Rockwell in Farmington Hills between March 31 and April 1.

■ THEFTS

A \$300 gold chain and \$400 in rolled coins were stolen from a residence at the Little Valley Trailer Park on Tuck in Farmington Hills March 26.

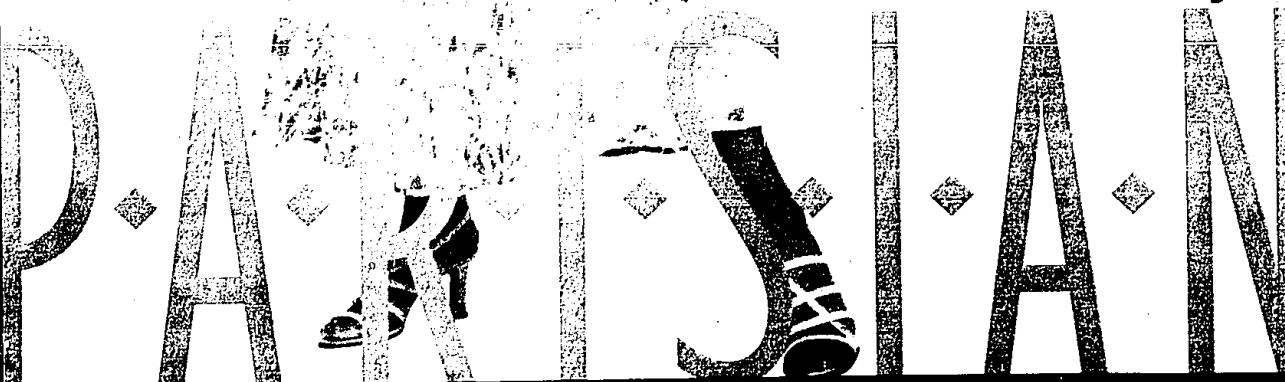
