

How can homeowners beat the summer's heat without burning up cover uir-conditioning bills? Many solve the problem by turn-ing a patio, carport or breezeway into a cool summer living room with the simple additon of screening.

To build three screen walls around a roofed patio, the following steps are recommended.

Each screen wall can be prefabricated as a unit, then secured. Begin by mounting 2 inch by 4 inch wood base strips along the patio floor and unit wall of the house _ drilling through masonry if necessary _ and measure the space within

the rectangles formed. You'll build a screen wall for each of these rectangles, then attach screening to the frames. Apply wood stains or other finishes before the screening is installed. Build the frames separately to fit the three spaced wently on 24-inch, 36-inch or 48-inch centers and it three are typical screen widths. A horizontal 'rub rail' activation between the floor, will add stability. Use the metal framing angles on corners where the vertical and horizontal beams are joined.

To provide an outside exit from the porch, use two 4 inch by 4 inch study to frame a door opening in one wall. You can then install a pre-made door easily.

Once the frames are finished, raise them into position and nail them to the floor and celling hase strips, then nail the corners together. Now, add the screening in each vertical saction by unrolling from the top down and stapling it into place. Cover the staples with wood studs.
