Current trends in corporate downsizing, "right-sizing" and restructuring, and the resulting uncertainty and loss of job security, may be increasing the stress that leads to workplace violence, says Stefanic Zin, director of em-

"After a downsizing effort, employees may initially feel a emse of abock and diabellef," Zin said, Following these initial feelings, Zin said omployees may feel anger, sadness and resentment. Later, employees may experience depression and envisely, feelings of betrayal and discontent, and finally, a loss of self-esteem. "All these feelings may contribute to a disgrunted employee acting out in violent ways," Zin said.
