## Trial date hasn't been set in Hills double arson-murder

No date has been set for the trial of two men accused of killing a Farmington Hills woman and her daughter in December.

Arthur Hollingsworth Cayce, of Farmington Hills, and George Tyrone Davis, of Westland, both 23, were arraigned Monday before Judge Barry Howard in Oakland Circuit Court where they pleaded

not guilty.

They are accused of killing Louise Bovair, 52, and her daughter Melissa, 21, at their Quail Hollow Court home on Dec. 19 and then setting the house on fire.

A pretrial date will be set once motions are heard. The two men had been bound over after a preliminary examination in 47th

District Court before Judge Maria Parker on April 12.

Cayce is also charged with abducting, raping and threatening to kill his former girl friend last Dec. 28. Both men are being held in the Oakland County Jail without bond. They would receive mandatory life sentences if convicted.

## Farmington, WB churches trek Walk Against Hunger Sunday

People in the world are starving... but folks in the Farmington area and West Bloomfield are trying to do something about it.

The 11th-annual Crop Walk Against Hunger will bring together members of about 20 churches for the fund-raising event on Sunday, May 5.

The walk will begin and end at the First United Methodist Church, 33112 Grand River, Farmington. It will take place rain or shine.

Registration begins at 1:15 p.m. with the walk starting at 2 p.m. The 10-kilometer route winds through the streets of Farmington and Farmington Hills.

Some 25 percent of funds raised will be divided between the local Salvation Army, Neighborhood House, St. Alexander's Food Cupboard and the Baldwin Community Kitchen. The remainder will go to Church World Services to help fight hunger worldwide.

"Last year, we raised \$35,500," said Sue Broadwell, a Crop Walk leader. "We were in the top 10 in Michigan and tops in the metro area."

The exhibition, which features figure skaters from 7 to 15, will include freestyle and show-type skating. In addition, arena staff skater Susan Schnoes will also perform.

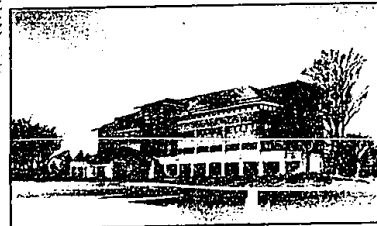
"We're hoping to have an ice

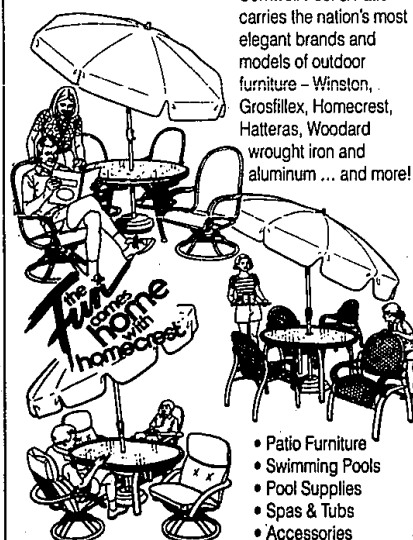
