

# Oakland CC sweeps softball doubleheader from Macomb CC

Joanne Margherzio's two-out double to left-center April 27 scored Melissa Ames from first base with the winning run, as Oakland Community College rallied to beat visiting Macomb Community College, 7-6, in the first game of a twin bill.

The Raiders pulled off the sweep by holding off a late Macomb charge in the second game for a 7-5 victory.

OCC improved to 29-8 overall and 15-1 in the MCCA East Section. Macomb dropped to 11-15 overall and 7-7 in the MCCA.

Trailing 3-2 in the fifth, the

Raiders rallied for three runs to take a 5-3 lead. The big hit in the inning was a two-run double by Dawn Lynn.

After adding a run in the sixth to take a 6-3 lead, Macomb came back to tie the game with a three-run seventh.

Amey Meldrum led the 12-hit OCC attack, going 3-for-3 while Ames was 3-for-4. Kelly Ross added a pair of hits and two RBI.

Marcie Lantz (15-4) won't throw distance for the victory.

In the nightcap, OCC took a 7-1 lead before holding off Macomb. Jamie Ban (13-3) allowed six hits in the complete game effort.

The difference in the game was again the fifth inning, when the Raiders erupted for four runs. The big blow was a three-run home run by Ross - her eighth of the season.

Lynn drove in three runs with a pair of hits, including a two-run double in the third.

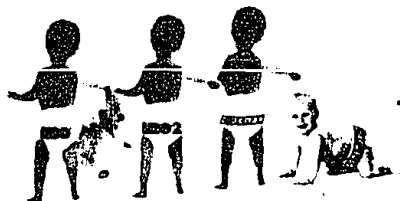

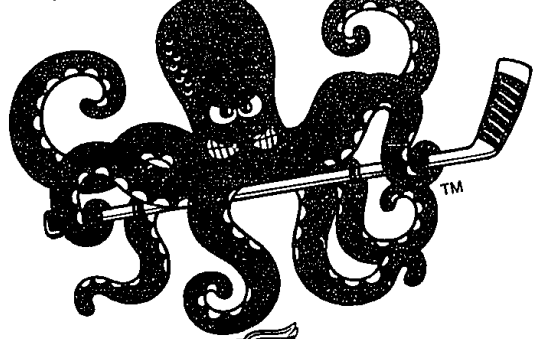
