Judge Marilyn Kelly of the Court of Appeals and Circuit Judge Jessica Cooper campaigned at last weekends 11th Congressional District convention, where the chief order to business was picking national convention delegates.

Two places are open. Chief Justice James H. Brickley, as Republican appointee and nominee, is seeking reelection. Justice Charles Levin, an independent of strong liberal bent, must retire because he is past age 70.

"She (Kelly) is one of the most studge-like peuple, in terms of temperament, I know," said state Rep. Maxine Berman, D. Southfield, in a speech for Kelly. She has been a stalwart supporter of this party.

Kelly, of Bloomfield Hills, has been on the state's second highest court since 1988 and earlier in her career spent 12 years on the State Board of Education.

She is making her second bid for the Supreme Court, whose candidates run on a nonpartisan hallot after being nominated by party conventions. 
