Insanely the Catch 22 syndrome is seen elsewhere throughout our society. Catch 22 is seen in teaching where the prospective instructor is required to take non-applied theory courses in education to learn how to teach applied, non-theory courses.

Catch 22 is seen in agriculture where the farmer threatens to go to work and plant more if he is paid less for planting less.

Catch 22 is seen in the new economics where there is talk of a guaranteed annual income and a guaranteed reduced work week. Catch 22 is seen in labor where the union leader talks of increased time for leisure and the union employee seeks an extra job so that he need not con-

front leisure.

CATCH 22 is seen in our educational systems which are avowedly anti-bureaucratic and yet have a greater number of administrators per worker than does IBM which is avowedly bureaucratic.

Catch 22 is seen in our government where money goes from our state systems to the Federal government so that it may be returned to the state systems.

GM Workers Get Living Hike

More than 450,000 General Motors hourly-rate employees received an eight-cent-an-hour pay increase on October 28 resulting from the rise in the consumer price index published by the Bureau of Labor Statistics.

The eight-cent-an-hour increase is the cost-of-living adjustment for the second year of the 1967 agreement between General Motors and unions representing its hourly-rate employees.

This eight-cent increase brings the total cost-of-living allowance to 13 cents an hour and is effective until October 27, 1969, at which time another review of the cost-of-living allowance is called for under the agreement.

The amount due an employee in cost-of-living allowance for straight time hours will be paid quarterly. The first period ends December 15.

The quarterly cost-of-living allowance for eligible General Motors' salaried employees will be increased \$40 -- from \$35 to \$55 effective Nov. 1. The \$65 amount will be paid quarterly until November 1, 1969, the next date of adjustment.
