## Newburgh Lake Stocked With 20,000 Trout

Newburgh Lake in Livonia was scheduled to be stocked with 20,000 brown trout fingerlings early this week.

The planting was the first of two in a State Conservation Department effort to provide better fishing in Western Wayne County.

A second planting is scheduled for Nov. 4, when 15,000 black bass will be planted in Newburgh and Wilcox lakes, both part of the Middle Rouge River chain which flows through the northwestern part of the county.

THE EXISTING fish population—mostly carp and stunted panfish—were killed several weeks ago by the Conservation Department.

The trout aren't expected to reproduce, but they will provide some sport fishing until the bass are big enough to take over. The brown, largest of the trout species, were started at a hatchery near Baldwin. Several southeastern Michigan locations were stocked this week. Newburgh is the second local lake to be stocked with trout. Phoenix Lake, upstream on the Plymouth-Northville border, received rainbow trout a year ago.

## Planners Table Action

A rezoning request for 2.6 acres at 32920 13 Mile (east of Farmington Road) has been tabled to see if the Farmington School District would be interested in the property.

Petitioning for a change from single family residential to office is Omar C. Sanderson, the property's option holder. The petition was tabled at the Oct. 24 planning commission public hearing after Canterbury Commons residents said they were not in favor of office zoning for the property.

In other planning commission action, a zoning ordinance revision to require two and a half parking spaces per apartment unit was tabled for further study. Developer, Thomas Duke told the planning commission that all apartment developments should not be required to meet blanket parking ordinances.

"You have to recognize the need of each apartment complex," Duke said.

The commission voted unanimously to study the ordinance change in connection with the number of bedrooms per complex.

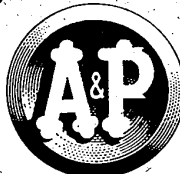
## Expensive Tool Kit Stolen
