Marlins, Hawks post dual-meet wins

Farmington Hills Mercy gave some of its key performers a rest Tuesday before the regional Saturday but still managed to edge Birmingham Marian 87-81 in a Catholic League girls track meet.

Jackie Segue won the 800-meter run (2:34.3) and helped two relay teams win their events as the Marlins improved to 3-1 in the Central Division and 1-1 overall.

Angie Morris helped the 400-meter relay team win its event and also finished second in two individual events.

Segue ran the first leg of the 3,200 relay team, which won with a time of 10:53.8. Christina Andriola, Molly Rottinghaus and Danielle Wroblewski ran the next three legs.

Lisa Nobles started the 1,600 relay team on its way to a first-place time of 4:26.6. Segue ran the second leg, followed by Erin Thomas and Andriola.

Marian's 800 relay team was disqualified as Mercy's won in 1:56. Casey Steward, Jamill Jackson, Natalie Grondin and Ashley Fields were the runners.

The 400 relay team's time was 52.2, with Morris leading off followed by Rashida Rudolph, Amy Buhl and Lynn Trakey.

Buhl won the 100 hurdles in 10 seconds with Jamie Snow second. Grondin was second in the high jump (4.4) while Morris was runnerup in the long jump (15.7/4) and 200 (28.8).

Stephanie Lyman threw the discus 83 feet to edge teammate Martha Obringer and win the event.

Andriola finished second in the 800, Molly Rottinghaus in the 1,600 and Wroblewski in the 3,200.

The Marlins will be host for the Catholic League A-B championships on Tuesday and the C-D meet on Wednesday.

The field events begin at 2:30 p.m. each day, running prelims at 3:30 and finals at 4:30. Admission is \$3 for adults and \$2 for students both days.

Hawks defeat Patriots
Devon Kennedy scored a pair of firsts and led two winning relay teams Tuesday to pace Farmington Harrison's 85-33 trouncing of Livonia Franklin.

Kennedy took the 100 hurdles (16.4), the 200 dash (27.5) and opened for the 400-meter relay.

Mahogany Fletcher won the 100 dash (13.7) and anchored the two winning relay teams begun by Kennedy.

Cierra Colbert ran the second leg in both races and Emily Mayberry the third as the 400 team recorded a time of 62.7. Lisa Sokol went third on the 800 team, which won in 1:54.

Harrison's 3,200 relay team also placed first as Sarah Rauch, Jackie Watts, Colleen Haggerty and Amy Schaner went 11:18 to win.

Mandi Berg won the discus (103.6) and Yoko Minner the high jump (4-8) as the host Hawks improved to 4-1 in

the Western Division and 4-2 overall.

Harrison's Amy Jenkins won the 300 hurdles in 52.6 while Sokol took the 400 run in 1:04.6 and Nikki Herman won the 800 run in 2:40.

"I like the way we're finishing the season, with a winning record," coach Mark Babcock said. "In the last three dual meets, we ran very strong. Our exchanges are better on the relays, and our times are coming down."

At the Lansing Waverly Invitational on Friday, Kennedy was second in the 200 (27.4) and Fletcher second in the long jump (15.1).

The Hawks had fourths from Jessica Turney in the shot put (31-3), Kennedy, 100 hurdles (16.6), Fletcher, 100 dash (13.4) and Sokol, 400 run (1:03.9). Finishing sixth were Mayberry in the 100 hurdles (17.0) and Allison Best in the 1,600 run (6:01).

The same fourswomen placed third in the 800 relay (1:51.7) and fourth in the 400 (53.6). Kristin Schleicher, Schaner, Julie Kluka and Best were sixth in the 3,200 relay (10:45.7).

North sets meet record
North Farmington broke a 10-year-old meet record in the discus relay Saturday at the Troy Atlanta Invitational.

The trio of Devonie Pinski, Melissa Gratz and Marie Casadeu combined for a 320-3 distance, bettering the mark of 312-8 set by Romeo in 1986. Pinski threw the discus 116-4, Gratz 112-3 and Casadeu 92-8.

"Even though the weather wasn't very good, they still did an excellent job," North coach Bill Pinnell said. "They were fired up because they knew the record was within their reach. All three threw to their season best."

The Raiders also were second in the 1,600 relay with the team of Ava Lala,

Vicky Hand, Monica Czerwinski and Heather Burcar running a 4:25.2 time.

Erika Anderson replaced Hand on the 800 relay team as North finished third in 1:51.4.

Burcar, Lala, Czerwinski and Sarah Kern were third (7:25.1) in the Athena Relay, which consisted of 800-meter

legs at the start and finish and two 200s in between.

The discus team also took fourth in the shot put (87-1 1/2), and Burcar, Katie Gelfy and Hand were fourth in the long jump (41-0).

The Raiders were sixth out of 16 teams with 23 points.
