Jack Nicklaus is a golfing legend.
Detroit-aren golf fans will have another opportunity to see him in action at this year's U.S. Open at Oakland Hills. The 56-year-old touring pro is one of 69 exempt players scheduled to compete for the national golf cham-

Nicklaus, who won the U.S. Senior Open hosted by Oakland Hills in 1991, has had a storied career.

has had a storied career.

He joined the tour in 1962 and went on to register at least one victory in each of his first 17 years as a pro. In total, Nicklaus owns 70 PGA tour victories, eight Senior PGA tour victories, and 14 international golf victories.

Nicklaus was inducted into the

Nicklaus was inducted into the World Golf Hall of Fame in 1974 and is considered by many to be one of the greatest tour players ever. He was the first tour players ever. He was the (121/173), \$3 million (5/2/77), \$4 million (121/173), and \$5 million (8/20/88)

marks in career earnings.

Nicklaus is the winner of 18 profes sional golf majors, including six Mas-ters, five PGAs, four U.S. Opens and three British Opens. He was the old-est player to win the Masters title (46)

Nicklaus, who attended Ohio State University, has residences in both North Palm Beach, Fla. and Muirfield Village, Ohio, and plays out of Muir-field Village (Ohio) Country Club.

NBC's announcing crew will be led

once again by Dick Enberg and chief analyst Johnny Miller.
