When funeral homes, cemeteries and pre-need companies employ commissioned salespeople to sell their services and merchandise, the truth can get muddy. Do these situations sound honest?

A funeral director sells a family a casket and a burial vault then tells them "everything is taken care of." Years later when the death occurs, they are told they must pay a service charge and additional expenses.

A cemetery owner selling a product tells a consumer "the price will double after today."

A pre-need company rents a casket for \$1,600 by telling the family the average casket sells for \$9,000. When the family gets to the funeral home, they learn that for \$1,400 they could have bought the same one.

My point is that it is hard to know with whom you are dealing. These salespeople may work for
