POLICE AND FIRE CALLS

Listed below are some of the Farmington-area police incidents, fire calls and court cases reported during the past week.

FIRE DEPARTMENT RUNS
Farmington Hills firefighters made 117 runs for the week of June 9-16 including 68 medical runs (58 percent), nine fires and seven rescue calls.

FIRE
In Farmington Hills:
Firefighters from Stations 1 and 3 responded to a stove fire at 5:25 p.m. June 14 at a residence on Rhonwood. The owner had put out the fire that started after he turned on the wrong burner. Damage to the property was \$100.

Firefighters from Station 1 put out an engine fire in a van at 10:01 p.m. June 14. The owner had just parked the van. Damage to the 1989 Ford van was \$7,668 and damage to contents was \$1,250.

Firefighters from Station 3 put out a mail box fire at a residence on Wildwood at 2:39 a.m. June 15 that caused \$200 in damage.

Firefighters from Station 4 put out a garbage truck fire on Hills Tech at 6:49 a.m. June 15. The cab was totally involved when firefighters arrived. The fire started when a hydraulic line broke spraying oil on a hot exhaust manifold causing it to ignite. Damage to the truck was \$60,000.

Firefighters from Station 1 put out an apartment fire that started in a kitchen near a dishwasher at the Green Hill Apartments on Green Hill at 11:37 a.m. June 16. The heating element in the dishwasher had melted, causing particle board to ignite. Damage was \$10,000 to property and \$5,000 to contents.

Firefighters from Stations 1 and 3 put out a fire in a laundry room at a residence on Jefferson at 5:22 p.m. June 16. The man smelled smoke while in the shower and escaped through a window in the duplex. Damage to the structure was \$25,000 and damage to contents was

\$15,000.
