And if you have an old-fashioned single-pane glass skylight or plastic hubble skylight installed you can end rustrating energy loss and possible leaks by simply replacing your outdated skylights with these new weathertight models.

The money you'll save in heating, cooling and home maintenance costs, coupled with the increase in home value, will more than make up for the cost of replacing these older units, says Gary Hyman, marketing manufacturer of roof windows and skylights.

The cost to replace did skylights is often a pleasant surprise to homeowners. According to Tom McKnown, president of Skypros, Inc., a firm specialting exclusively in skylight installations, the average cost of replacing a two-foot by four-foot bubble with a fixed skylight to that cannot be opened is under \$500 and slightly more for steep or flat roofs. A ventilating skylight, commonly used in high-humidity areas such as kitchens and bathrooms, costs about \$650 for the same application.

Manufacturers such as Velux are designing skyfights with insulated, argon-filled glass panes that feature energy-efficient coatings. These coatings prevent heat gain in summer months by blocking most of the sun's infrared energy from entering the home, and heat loss in winter by reflecting warm air back in the home, reducing heating and cooling bills.

Because skylight flashing (or waterproofing) systems have improved tremendously skylights can now be easily installed with any type roofing material including metal, asphalt or fiberglass shingles, slate, cedur shingles and shake. Spanish and concrete tiles.
