## Isuzu truck that's as American as you can get

Can you really buy a for-eign par or truck and call it American?

Yep. Here's a vehicle that's got a "foreign" name, but it's really all-American.

This Isuzu Hombre is 92 percent U.S./Canadian parts content, has a powertrain and transmission built here in the transmission built here in the U.S. has a General Motors platform and is assembled in Shregeport, La., at a General Motors truck plant right alongside the Chevrolet S-10.

-That's more American than the last Mercury I owned. The remaining 8 percent of the Hombre is made by GM in Brazi, by the way. Hence the name. I guess.

The only transmission available is a 5-speed manual with integral overdrive. All Hombre models are 2 wheel drive. That's a good choice because industry statistics show 76 percent of all light-duty pickup use calls for 2-

There are two models to choose from: An S that has bench seats, or an upgraded XS, which has a 60/40 split bench seat. A driver's-side airbag is standard in both the S and XS.

The Isuzu Hombre XS is equipped with quite a bit of stuff usually reserved for the option list on most small pickup trucks out there, like a sliding rear window, cut-pile carpeting, rear step bumper, air conditioning, tachometer. digital clock and an AM/FM cassette stereo with four speakers.

The Hombre is safe. Sideimpact door beams, 3-point safety belts, 4-wheel anti-lock brakes, a collapsible steering column, side-guard door beams, safety-cage construc-tion, intermittent windshield wipers, daytime running lamps and roadside assistance are there to protect you.

The Hombre also is equipped with 100,000-mile replacement spark plugs and a maintenance-free battery. The warranty is 36 menths or 50,000 mile limited basic; 60

month, 60,000 mile limited powertrain; and 72 month or 100,000 mile limited anti-cor-

That's all well and good. But what you need to know is, this mini-truck is solid, functional and fun to drive. A good choice for people who appreciate those qualities.
