"I don't want to invite people to have us pay the postage. But if we didn't pay the postage due, it could cost us more."

Rose-Haite said the city and post office are working together to make sure the city gets any postage due ballots.

Farmington Clerk/Treasurer Patsy Cantrell said that city hasn't had any problems because

Deputy City Clerk Sue Rose-Haite said two years ago the envelopes had instructed voters to place one stamp on the envelope, which required more than one first-class stamp.

"We heard about that one," Rose-Haite said. "We changed it

absentee ballots have been turned in by hand.

She said the city included the amount of postage required in the material it sent out to absentee voters.

"We don't have a policy (on postage due)," she said. "But we would expect to accept those ballots on deadline."

Under Michigan law, only the voter or an immediate family member can turn in an absentee ballot. It is a felony for anyone else to turn in that ballot. And a voter can not request the ballot be picked up if he or she is physically able to mail or take in to the city hall.
