One of the largest misunderstandings when purchasing ceramic tile is determining the size to purchase. The average consumer believes that if the room is small the tile must be small. The disadvantage of purchasing small tile is that more grout lines will appear making either your floor or wall look busy. The large tile allows less grout lines, less maintenance, and enhances the beauty of the ceramic tile because you see more of a ceramic surface. A popular statement used is "Consumers spend a lot of money on their tile so they should rather see the tile then the grout lines." Popular sizes being used for bathroom walls range from 8" x 10" up to 16" x 16". Floor tiles are very common in 12" x 12" up to 18" x 18".


