Get ready to start your engines and shift into high gear for Dream Cruise 1996, a truly extraordinary event that draws participants to Oakland County from all over America.

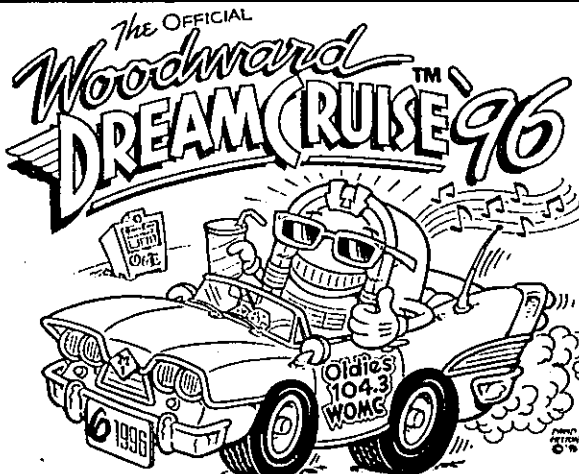
