THEFT

In Farmington:

SHOPLIFTING

In Farmington:

A Detroit man was arrested for shoplifting \$210 worth of merchandise from Kmart at Grand River and Halsted at 11:39 a.m. Oct. 8.

DRUNKEN DRIVING

In Farmington:

A Hills woman was arrested for drunken driving after police noticed her 1996 Ford Taurus drifting between lanes at Grand River and Drake at 12:36 a.m. Oct. 10. She refused her preliminary blood test. In Farmington Hills.

Police arrested a West Bloomfield man, 30, at 1:02 a.m. Oct. 8 for driving a blue 1984 Ford F-150 north on Inkster south of 10 Mile while drunk. The pickup was driving erratically. The driver had a blood alcohol level of .16 percent. A level of .1 percent is considered too drunk to drive in Michigan.

Police arrested a Brighton man, 36, for drunken driving, urinating in public and carrying a concealed weapon at 2:15 a.m. Oct. 9 in the parking lot of Dei Man on Grand River at Middlebelt. Officers saw the man urinating out of the driver's door of a red 1993 Honda Civic. The man had a blood alcohol level of .13 percent. A search of the car revealed a 9 mm pistol with ammunition.

Police arrested a Commerce Township man, 35, for driving a silver 1992 Lincoln Towncar on Freedom at Drake at 8:35 p.m. Oct. 9 while drunk. The driver had a blood alcohol level of .11 percent.

Police arrested a Novi woman, 37, for driving a red 1993 Ford Escort on Haggerty north of Nine Mile at 11:50 p.m. Oct. 9 while drunk. The car was involved in an accident. The driver had a blood alcohol level of .2 percent.

STALKING

In Farmington Hills:

Police are seeking a warrant against a woman, 32, for making repeated threatening calls to a Farmington Hills police detective. Judge Fred Harris had sentenced the woman to 60 days in jail for making threatening, harassing calls to the detective on Sept. 14, but suspended the sentence with the provision that the woman have no further contact with the detective. The detective has since received more threatening calls from the woman and submitted voice mail tapes to the 47th District Court.

DOMESTIC VIOLENCE

Police arrested a Hills woman, 43, for slapping her husband at their residence at 9:15 p.m. Oct. 8. Further investigation turned up two bags containing 46 ounces of marijuana in the woman's purse.

DRUGS
