Center offers women quick results of mammograms

When it comes to breast cancer detection, women know exactly what they want — convenience and immediate results.

"Women shouldn't have to wait for the results of their mammogram," says Cheryl Grigorian, M.D., medical director of the Barbara Ann Karmanos Cancer Institute's Berkeley Breast Cancer Detection Center.

"Eighty percent of breast lumps and calcifications are benign. Why wait in fear?"

The institute's breast cancer detection services include screening mammography, a clinical breast exam and instruction in breast self examination. Patients receive preliminary mammography results from the physician at the time of their visit.

"Mammography doesn't prevent breast cancer," Grigorian notes. "But for women diagnosed with the disease, proper screening will dramatically increase their chances for survival and cure."

Breast cancer, when found at its earliest, most treatable stages, is more than 90 percent curable.

To make breast cancer screening more accessible to working women, the center also offers Saturday hours; call the Berkeley site for appointment times at 643-7892.

The Karmanos Cancer Institute is one of the nation's leading cancer research, treatment, education and outreach centers. It is affiliated with the Detroit Medical Center and Wayne State University, and supported by several United Ways.
