Her fiancé is a graduate of Rochester Adams and General Motors Institute. He is employed by Rockwell in Troy.



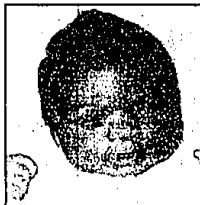

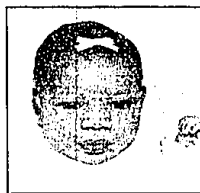


Lauryn Rene Johnson

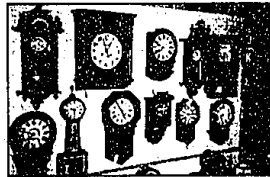

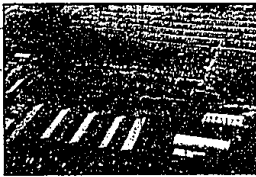
