## Road snow teams ready with 80,000 tons of salt

The Beverly Hills-based Road Commission for Oakland County will be ready for winter's enslaught. Even a few snowflakes right now should not be a problem, said commission spokesman Scott Kingan, because ground temperatures have not follen dramaticuly. If slippery conditions are encountered, Kingan said, they will be asen on overpasses and bridge decks.

Orders have been placed for upito 80,000 tons of road salt except the roads passable this withter, reports maintenance department director James Dunleavy. In a normal winter, a S28 a ton, the road commission will spend about \$2.24 million just for sait.

'The fact is, whether on the basis of cost or overall effectiveness, salt remains the best available product to help ensure the safety of the motoring public, said Dunleavy.

While salt will again be used on many of the 2,500 miles of roads the commission is responsible for maintaining, aslt can't be used on gravel roads; sand is used instead. Conversely, because it has no melting ability and can eventually clog sewers and storm drains, sand is used only selectively on paved roads.

The road commission has fact of 140 salt trucks and 24 graders. They travel 96 pre-stablished routes created based on traffic flow volumes and the

amount of time it takes drivers to complete each route.

A systematic elert system is used to call in drivers in the event of precipitation that occurs outside of regular working hours. From Nov. 1 to mid April, the road commission has a designated Snow Duty Officer on call 24 hours a day. These peeple follow guidelines to decide how many drivers to call in and when the system of the system

salt on the roads. It is often while receiving overtime pay that much of the road salt is applied. For the 1950-97 without the road commission has budget ed some \$2.2 million for overtime coats.

Trucks and other road equipment are another major cost of grappling with winter, Dunleavy said. There is nothing more damaging to a truck that winter maintenance. Our seven- and 12 yard dump trucks (which cost \$85,000 to \$98,000 respectively), carry many heavy loads of corroive sailt. The vibration of the plowa against the roads also two weaks have con them. Maintenance of these vehicles is critical and so is our need to replace them on a timely basis. Even so, we manage to get about 10 years of service from our trucks and about 15 years for the \$140,000-a-copy graders.

As new trucks are ordered, the road commission is equipping them with a computerized salt

in Waterford Township indicate when slippery conditions have been detected.

Another common situation in winter creates a kind of public relations problem. 'Our Citizen. Services Department and dispatchers often receive many calls from people asking about when their roads will be plowed or insisting that they must be. One person called to insist we clear their road and driveway because

they were going to miss an air-line flight. The problem is we always have the responsibility to-make primary roads aafe and passable first. Only after that can we turn our attention to other roads or subdivision streets, Kingan said.

All drivers are receiving addi-tional, special training conduct-ed each year at the Michigan Center for Decision Driving at the Eaton Proving Grounds.
