Her fiancé is a graduate of the University of Michigan. He is employed at Quinlan Associates, architects in St. Clair Shores.

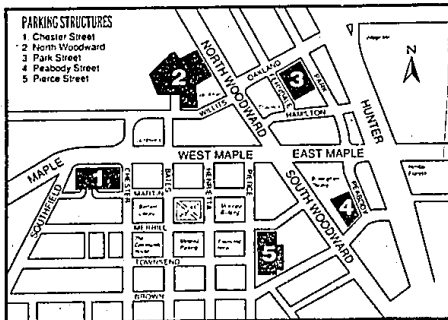
