"I learned how to pray, how toconnect with our creator," said the

The Wasilewskis' growing passion for intercessory prayer spilled 
into the workplace last summer 
when the couple hung manila 
envelopes for prayer requests at 
their two businesses, Custom Serviers, Ltd. in Madison Heights and 
Joseph O's in Hazel Park.

"We wanted people who worked 
in our businesses to know that we 
care about them," said Rose, "And 
for people without a church, this 
may be their only opportunity to 
get to know God."

When the manila envelopes 
Quickly filled with requests, the 
Oakland County natives began formulating a more eye-catching display, which led to the shirt design 
with postage-paid mailers tucked 
in the pocket closest to the heart."

The couple put up their own funds to finance the artwork, printing, postal account, copyright and a hottine for information and anonymous reports. But not without first calling on the Lord.

"We don't do anything without prayer," said Rose. "We feel honored that the Lord would use us."

In August, the Wasilewskis presented Prayer Pockets to fellow members of Woodlawn Church asking for their support. Ray Howell of Beverly Hills is among those involved with the new ministry.

"It spoke to my spirit," said the retired draftsman. "So many times, people need prayer and yet it's a personal, sensitive matter. They don't want to speak it out. This allows them to write down and express what their needs are."

Howell maintains a Prayer Pockets display for his friend, Lorraine Marsh, who sells Shaklee products in Lathrup Villags. The cardboard pocket of prayer request forms has become an extension of Marsh's total wellness business.

"If people come in talking about problems, i suggest they write a letter to God," and Marsh, a member of St. Bede Catholic Church in Southfield. "It's all part of total wellness... spiritually, physically, environmentally and financially."
Woodlawn Church member Mike Conley, owner of D. J. Conley Associates, Inc. in Troy, put up a Prayer Pockets display primarily for the benefit of his 18 employees. "It's in a place where it's conspicuous enough, where you can either ignore it or participate. It's not intimidating by any means, said Conley, a Sterling Heights resident. "It's an option for them to tap into a resource that they might not know was available to them ... a means where someons might find a sense of help or closure in their life."

The Prayer Pockets ministry currently draws two mailers each day. Anonymous callers to the praise hotline have told of prayer requests being granted for marriage reconciliation,

arthritic healing, a home sale, a new job and a healthy newborn. The Wasilowskis' oldeat daughter, Melanie, supports the fledgling ministry with a Prayer Pockets display in her office at the K-Mart headquartors in Troy. Displays can also be found in more than a dozen other businesses in Metro Detroit.

The Wasilowskis, who also have a 12-year-old daughter, Kendra, have continued to finance the growing, three-month old ministry because 'we fiel that committed to prayer.' said Rose.

"It's not just a tithe of money that we're called to give, it's also a tithe of our time and being obedient to what God wants us to do," added Michael. "God has blessed our business. This is a way of sowing back into God's kingdom." For more information about
