Bennett bill OK'd

Bennett bill OK'd

The Legislature has completed work on a bill by Sen. Loren Bennett, R-Canton, to prevent people from placing faise liens on property as a form of intimidation and harassment.

The Senate voted 33-0 to concur in House amendments to SB 828 and sent the bill to Gov. Engler for signing.

Law enforcement groups complained that anti-government groups placed false liens against

the homes of police officers and other public officials.
"Now, not only will the property owner be notified and provided with a full and fair accounting of the facts," said Bennett, "but if an individual files a lien without lawful cause and with intent to harass, that individual may be charged with a felony offense."

Liquor bill OK'd

a Senate-approved bill to privatize the state liquor wholesale industry.
Senate Bill 1171, approved 34-2, prohibits the Liquor Control Commission from charging fees for "split" cases and new delivery fees, a protection for rural areas. "This legislation ensures distilled spirits will continue to be available statewide with no interruptions in service and at no increased costs," said Sen. Willis Bullard Jr., R.Millord, The LCC currently runs 63

small warehouses. On Jan. 12; an executive order by the gover-nor could increase the number of distribution outlets to 3,000

distribution outlets to 3,000 statewide.

SB 1171 also keeps intact a three-tier system for distribution — manufacturers, which must remain independent of each other. It reduces the state's markup on alcohol from 65 percent to a maximum of 56 percent.
